Course Description

This course is designed for students who are interested in film studies and in Science Fiction as a genre. We will explore questions about what Science Fiction is and how it has influenced and been influenced by American culture since the early days of film. We will focus on the last 25 years or so: the post Industrial Light and Magic revolution—and the emergence of Science Fiction as a significant film genre with enormous cultural interest.

Student Responsibilities

Students are expected to be on time and prepared for class. Since we only meet once a week and no one in their right mind would want to miss this class, absences will adversely affect grades. Class participation is seriously expected. Also, students are expected to be respectful of each other and to know how to disagree without being either disagreeable or insulting to others in the class.

Students will be required to write two papers 10-12 pages in length. One paper will be due at mid-term (February 28th) and one at the end of the semester. The first paper will be on an SF film made before 1960;the second one will be on a film made after 1960 that we do not screen in class. These papers and class "quality" participation will each count as 33% of the final grade.
