INTRODUCTION TO G-STABLE PIECES

ABSTRACT: The notation of *G*-stable pieces was introduced by Lusztig in the study of parabolic character sheaves. It has a rich structure, combining combinatorics, group theory, geometric representation theory and other fields. In this talk, we will discuss the *G*-stable pieces from the point of view of combinatorics of Weyl groups. We will also talk about some connection with algebraic geometry and Poisson geometry.
