The U.S. Department of Energy has released its FY 2012 Funding Opportunity Announcements (FOAs) to support university and college efforts to build or expand their school's nuclear science and engineering basic research or education capabilities, in support of the next generation of nuclear scientists and engineers conducting research at colleges and universities across the country. The Department will provide funds to upgrade university level research reactors and purchase general scientific equipment and instrumentation.

The goal of the **Infrastructure** program is to enable and support the education and training of nuclear scientists, engineers, and policy-makers in graduate and undergraduate study and two-year programs who are conducting research that furthers the goals of the Department and the nuclear energy industry.

NEUP sets a limitation of **ONE** application per University for the **General Scientific Infrastructure Support Program**. Faculty interested in submitting a proposal should send to Elaine Riberich (Office of Research, 123 University Place, 47413, emr@pitt.edu) by **November 30, 2011** a description of their proposed project so that appropriate action can be taken to ensure that the University submits only one application. If more than one proposal is received a review committee will be convened to determine whose project goes forward for the **February 8, 2012 deadline**.
