As a representative of Engineers Without Borders (EWB) at the University of Pittsburgh I would like to inform you of an upcoming engineering professionals' event. In conjunction with the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra we are hosting *the 2nd annual Engineers Night with the Symphony* and inviting local companies, professionals and students for a night of networking and a POPs musical performance.

We are currently reaching out to the local business community for sponsorships of this event. There are two separate sponsorships we are offering: executive sponsorship at \$500 and premier sponsorship at \$1000. Both sponsorships will provide a table for the company to advertise themselves to students. Please note that sponsorships are not tax deductible.

The executive sponsorship will also come with two tickets to the event while the premier will come with four tickets. Banners and pamphlets made will raise awareness of the contributor's company by displaying their logo according to sponsorship level. The sponsorships will be used to directly fund event costs and anything made over the event cost will be put into our project's construction in Mali, Africa.

The event starts at 7:00pm on Thursday, February 25th 2010 in downtown Pittsburgh at Heinz Hall. The night will begin with a POPs performance by the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra. After this performance a dessert reception and networking event will be held in a banquet hall at Heinz Hall. Additional tickets are being sold at \$50 apiece.

EWB is an international, non-profit, humanitarian organization dedicated to improving the quality of life in developing local and worldwide communities. EWB pledges to address problems affecting health, sanitation, economy, technology and education with community-appropriate sustainable solutions. At the University of Pittsburgh, our student run organization is working to design, implement and maintain a fish farm for Makili, a malnourished community in Mali, Africa. A separate local project is being started with the Carnegie Library of Braddock within the next months.
