



**“Dallaht Gahwa”
(Coffee jug)**

**“Sujadat Salah”
(Prayer Rug)**

Muslims have to pray on a clean place. So we use this rug to pray on it. Though its not required to use it for praying, but Muslims use it if the place was dirty. A long time ago, it was made of palm tree flickers. Nowadays, its made of different kinds of cloths.

**“Merwaha”
(Hand fan)**

In hot weather, the “Merwaha” is used by hands to fan some cool air. It was used a long time ago. Some people use it now though. It is made of dry palm tree flickers.



**“Ibreeg Shahee”
(Tea jug)**

Tea jugs are made of metal, they are used to serve tea in them.



**“Dawrag ZamZam”
(ZamZam water jug)**

In the old days, ZamZam water was put in such jug made of clay to cool the water. In public areas, some people volunteer to walk around and serve some of the Zamzam water for free..

Muslims believe that Zamzam is the holy water that comes from heaven. It has a special taste that no other water in the planet has.

It has started when Ishmael was a baby with his mother Hager in Makkah after his father “Abraham” left them as he was ordered by God. The water is a miracle from God to feed the baby and his mother where no one around were there to help. ZamZam water still exist and never stopped since then. In addition, it has never experienced any shortage, although in hajj season more than 4 million people drink and use it for different purposes.



**“Menfakh”
(Air blower)**

When we go camping in the desert, we use this product to blow air and light the camp fire. Some people use it in their house fireplace.
