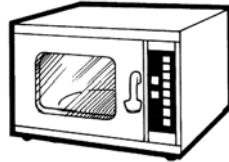

## What We Provide

The following items are provided in every apartment at Westmoreland Hall:

- Air Conditioning
- Bed
- Carpeting
- Chests
- Desks (1 per student)
- Internet service
- Microwave and full-size refrigerator
- Kitchen sink
- Mini blinds
- Shower curtain
- Smoke detectors
- Telephone (in common area)
- Wastebaskets



In addition, the following items are available at the front desk area:

- Board games
- Broom, mop, dustpan
- Garbage bags
- Iron & ironing board
- Toilet tissue
- Vacuum cleaners



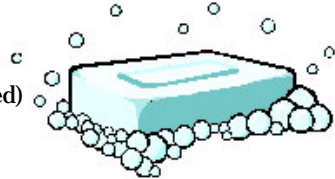
Other provided services and amenities include:

- Basic cable TV service
- Coin-operated laundry facilities
- Storage
- Study Lounges
- TV Lounge
- Vending machines

## What You Should Bring – “The Necessities”

Below is a list of several general necessity items you may want to consider bringing along when you move into Westmoreland Hall:

- Alarm clock
- Answering machine
- Bedding (beds are extra long, twin size – 80 inches)
- Cable cord
- Cleaning products
- Computer and Ethernet cord
- Dishes
- First aid kit (bandages, thermometer, medications, etc)
- Hangers
- Laundry supplies (detergent, basket, etc.)
- Microwaveable containers
- Printer and paper
- Surge protector
- Toaster (toaster ovens are not permitted)
- Toiletries, towels, and wash cloths
- TV, VCR/DVD player, and stereo



## What You Should NOT Bring

While we want you to feel at home in your apartment, several items are prohibited due to various health, safety, and/or academic reasons. These items include:

- Alcohol (including any alcoholic bottle/can collections)
- Amplified instruments
- Appliances with exposed elements (including hot plates and toaster ovens)
- Candles (unless used exclusively for decoration; wick must not be burnt)
- Illicit drugs
- Electrical appliances with frayed or non-UL listed cords
- Explosives, including fireworks/firecrackers
- Flammable liquids
- Halogen lamps
- Heaters of any type
- Incense
- Kerosene lamps
- Pets (except fish in a 10 gallon tank or smaller)
- Upholstered furnishings (including futons)
- Weapons
- Weightlifting equipment over 50 pounds



## Other Items You May Want to Bring Along

You may also want to consider bringing the following items:

- Bean bag chair
- Coffee pot
- Cordless phone
- Curtains & curtain rod (no holes may be put in walls)
- Desk lamp
- Dry erase and/or cork board
- Ear plugs and headphones
- Envelopes, postcards, stamps
- Fish
- Flash drive and/or computer disks
- Flashlight
- Mattress pad
- Music, movies, and games
- Food & snacks
- Pens, pencils, tape, stapler, note cards, scissors, etc.
- Picture frames and photos; posters; and other decorations
- Potted plants
- Quarters (for laundry and vending machines)
- Sewing kit
- Storage boxes/containers
- Umbrella



**NOTE:** Be sure to contact your roommates prior to move-in day to determine who will bring what items for the common area. For instance, there is no need for two roommates to bring answering machines.
