NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT  
SCHOLARSHIP**

**RATIONALE**

This scholarship was established to recognize and honor those who have made a commitment to returning to school and demonstrating a positive influence to the campus community. This scholarship is \$500.00 and is applied directly to the student's account during the following academic term. The scholarship will be awarded to non-traditional students who are enrolled at the University of Pittsburgh at Greensburg at least half-time (6 credits).

**ELIGIBILITY**

The scholarship will be awarded to non-traditional students who are **23 years of age or older**. The student must register for at least 6 credits for the following academic term and must also be currently enrolled at UPG. The student must be in good academic standing with a QPA of 2.75 or higher. A list of further requirements is provided with this packet. No Non-traditional scholarship committee member may apply.

**SELECTION**

The selection committee will consist of two SGA members, two faculty members, and the Dean of Student Services or his/her designee. The student's QPA, community involvement and essay will be the main considerations for the scholarship. A student may receive the award only once. The committee reserves the right not to award the scholarship during a given term.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Each applicant must complete an application, write a 250 word essay stating why you should be the recipient of the Non-Traditional Student Scholarship, provide a copy of their UPG transcript, their student involvement transcript, and enclose one letter of recommendation from a faculty member at UPG. **Application material should be submitted in a sealed envelope. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**

Applications are due March 6th, 2008 at **Noon** in the Student Services office in 212 Chambers Hall. Applications should be given directly to a SGA member or to the SGA advisor (in 219 Chambers Hall) and not put under the door. If mailing is more convenient, please mail application in a sealed envelope to: **UPG SGA, 212 Chambers Hall, University of Pittsburgh Greensburg, 150 Finoli Drive, Greensburg, PA, 15601**. Mailed applications should be postmarked by the deadline. **NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
