This fall each student organization will become a part of the **4th Annual Organizational Challenge**. Each organization will have the opportunity to move through the three levels to reach the highest point of achievement, Gold Status.

To achieve **Bronze Status**, the organization must meet the following requirements and deadlines listed below for the academic year. All paperwork must be turned in on time.

- Attend President's Meeting
- Submit your current Organizational roster on-line
- Submit Non-Hazing Compliance Form with signatures
- Participate in the Activities Fair
- Submit the Summary Report Form, which lists all your Service Projects

To move from Bronze to **Silver Status**, the organization must meet the requirements listed below:

- Plan at least one program/activity for your organization each academic semester.
- Attend at least one leadership program sponsored by University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown or by a regional/national organization (program approved by Student Activities).
- Participate in Leukemia/Lymphoma Society Light the Night Walk Project.

To move from Silver to **Gold Status**, the organization must meet the requirements listed below:

- Participate in one community service project (50% of members must be in attendance).
- Hold one program that benefits the Pitt-Johnstown general student population.
- Participate in at least one Homecoming Weekend Activity, September 24-26, such as Window Painting, the Float Competition, or volunteer with Student Activities to "work" an event.
