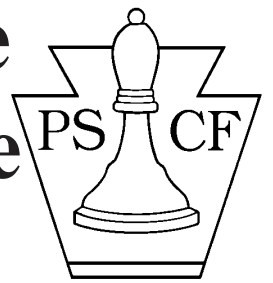


2021 Pennsylvania Online Scholastic Chess Challenge



May 22

Due to the current pandemic, we were not able to hold our annual scholastic championships in 2021. In lieu of that event, we wanted to give Pennsylvania Scholastic players an opportunity to play in an on-line event against other scholastic players from across the state. This event will be USCF-rated in the Online Regular rating system. So you will need to have a current USCF membership in order to register. For seedings, pairings and prizes we will be using your Regular Over-The-Board rating as of the May 2021 rating supplement. All registration must be done on-line by midnight May 10 at:

While the event will be held on May 22, there will be a free practice tournament to familiarize you with the ChessKid system, the week before on May 15. It will start at 10 AM and will be a 4 round Swiss, Game/8 Minutes with 1-second Increment. The results will not count toward the main event, nor will it be USCF-rated. We encourage all who register to participate in this warm-up. This will make sure your event username and password work and help to resolve any connectivity issues.
