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The activity was conducted by Center of Excellence, LUMHS Jamshoro in collaboration with World Health Organization.

December 23 – 27, 2013

Objectives:

The objectives of follow-up after training are to:

- Reinforce IMCI skills and help health workers transfer these skills to clinical work in facilities;
- Identify problems faced by health workers in managing cases and help solve these problems; and
- ➤ Gather information on the performance of health workers and the conditions that influence performance, in order to improve the implementation of IMCI.

Proceeding:

Methodology:

All selected supervisors were trained on day 1 for follow-up activity. They were provided checklists, supervisors guide and required stationery. On day 2 and day 3 transports was provided and they were assigned one facility per day to assess the health workers as to how they were implementing IMNCI protocols, if trained persons (Nominated) was not available then already trained person had to be evaluated. On day 4 a debriefing meeting was conducted to summarize the visit of health facilities.

Quality and Case Management Observed:

- > We found that most of health workers are not assessing the child as per IMNCI protocol.
- Majority of health workers are not assessing general danger signs, not advising home care and not advising for follow-up.
- > Health workers were not calculating the medicine dose and not checking the understanding of care taker.

Problems of Facility Support:

- Under 5 clinics were not available in most of health facilities except LUH, OPD Jamshoro and THQ Manjhand.
- > No IMNCI Chart booklet and case recording from available at most of health facilities.
- > No functioning ORT corner available at most of facilities.
- Immunization services were not available on the daily basis for e.g. BCG, and Measles in almost all centers were offered on specific days

Following drugs were not being supplied in most of health facilities at primary health care level.

- 1. ACT
- 2. Chloramphenicol Eye ointment
- 3. Ciprofloxacin
- 4. Inj. Quinine
- 5. Inj. Benzyl penicillin
- 6. Inj. Chloramphenicol

Following drugs were out of stock in most of health facilities at primary health care level

- 1. Syp: Zinc
- 2. Syp: Iron
- 3. ORS
- 4. Capsule Vitamin A
- 5. Tab: Mebendazole

Solutions:

- We requested health workers to bring chart booklet and properly assess, manage and give treatment according to IMNCI protocols.
- Health workers were informed that case recording forms were not necessary for under 5 OPD, they can follow the forms in chart booklet and write on OPD slip
- ➢ We instructed the store keeper, pharmacist and vaccinator to send indent two months before the end of stock for proper availability of medicine.
- We have to suggest to DHO/DSM to establish the ORT corner, ensure presence of staff and vaccines in EPI center, and availability of medicines in OPD. Separate under 5 clinics will be suggested where feasible.

Future planning:

- ➢ All the check lists should be reviewed.
- > IMNCI Follow-up should be conducted within a month after 11 Days training.
- > Accessibility of route plan should be justified by availability of transport
- All the DHO's and DSM's should be informed ten days before the follow-up visit and person nominated should be present on follow-up date at their health facilities.
